Organize a 'Walk to School Fashion Show' during IWALK Week featuring clothing for safe and fun walking! Use some of the 'rock and walk' tunes provided in this package.

Here are some fun theme ideas:

- Decorate or paint walk to school t-shirts!
- Create your own funky shoes!
- Cool rubber boots for puddle jumping!
- "Sou'westers" give the school a little twang!



- Colourful umbrellas to encourage walking in wet weather!
- Reflective items to increase your visibility!
- Bright, bright, bright clothing - **be safe, be seen**
- Have fun with reflective tags - turn off lights and use flashlights to demonstrate impact of reflective materials

Messages to include in your fashion show:

- Display a bright banner - **BE SAFE, BE SEEN**
- Look all ways before crossing the street and keep looking while you cross.
- When there is no sidewalk, walk on the left side of the road facing traffic.



- Make eye contact with drivers.
- Don't cross until cars have stopped.
- Beware of intersections without lights.
- Don't cross the road between parked cars.
- Play in places away from traffic.
- Use caution around railway tracks. Cross only at designated crossings, with an adult.
- Obey the rules of the road ALWAYS.
